



LAKE INFORMATION/ACTIVITIES

For current lake levels you can call our reservationist or the Bureau of Reclamation at (530) 275-1554 Monday to Friday. Besides fantastic houseboating, Shasta Lake offers wakeboard/water ski schools, Lake Shasta Caverns, numerous walking and biking trails and excellent fishing. The greater Redding area has five local golf courses, live theater, symphony performances, rodeos, and many fine dining locations. WHAT TO BRING

Your houseboat comes equipped with trash bags, coffee filters, dishwasher soap and toilet tissue. Review the following houseboat inventory carefully as you decide what to bring. The less you pack in the less you'll have to pack out.

You will be responsible for your own bedding, bath and kitchen towels, paper towels, and personal sundries. Don't forget to bring along your cell phone, binoculars, camera, flashlight, sunscreen and fishing gear. Visit houseboats.com for more details.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

For your personal safety and the protection of our houseboat fleet, water balloons and launchers, golf clubs and golf balls, tiki torches and extra fuel are not permitted.

- Place settings/silverware for 12, 15 or 16

- Kitchen utensils/BBQ tools
- Cookware/bakeware/serving bowls
- Beverage pitcher/drinking glasses/coffee mugs
- Electric coffee maker/toaster/blender/tea kettle
- Mop/broom/dust pan/deck brush/all-purpose cleaner



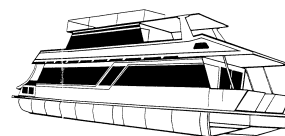

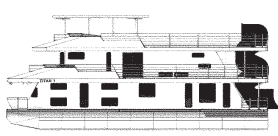

FOOD AND SUPPLIES

You will want to shop for your major provisions including fresh produce and meat products before you arrive. Redding is only 17 miles away and has several supermarkets including Costco. Jones Valley Resort's Marina Store is a fully stocked convenience store. We carry beer, wine, soft drinks, grocery items, personal sundries, ice cream, and dairy products. We also offer a great variety of fishing tackle and live bait. Be sure to check out our unique T-shirts and sports-wear.

ARRIVAL

Houseboat boarding commences between **2pm and 5pm**. There is no need to arrive at the marina more than one (1) hour prior to boarding. **Please, inform your entire crew of this.**

PARKING

Parking will change throughout the year due to fluctuating lake levels. A parking attendant will be available to direct you to the best parking location. Upon arrival, when you're checking in with the reservationist, please allow ample room for vehicles to pass you. Leave room for yourself to loop to any top lots. You will receive a courtesy parking pass upon check-in. *The loading zone is intended for loading and unloading only.* If you park in the loading zone when you arrive, it will inhibit other customers and delay the loading of your own houseboat.

DELIVERY SERVICE

Aquad with trailer is usually available to shuttle your belongings to and from your vehicle and houseboat. Simply relay to our staff upon arrival that you would like this service. You will then be directed to a "designated driver" available to load and/or unload your items.

CHECK-IN

You, the contracted party, are responsible for check-in. Unless prior arrangements have been made, you must be present *with a co-captain* to review and sign the rental agreement. You both must be at least 25 years old. If you cannot meet this requirement a houseboat will not be assigned and your rental fee could be forfeited.

Note: A completed Guest Manifest is required from each party. To save time, you can download the form at houseboats.com. Click on "Trip Preparation", then "Prior to Arrival".

RENTAL AGREEMENT

The rental agreement is a basic rental contract with an optional collision deductible waiver. Insurance terms are detailed at houseboats.com (click on "More Info - FAQ") and will be reviewed during the check-in process. All insurance fees are payable when signing the rental agreement.

LOADING/BOARDING

To help speed the check-in process for all our guests, we ask that you *do not unload any belongings from your vehicle until a houseboat has been assigned*. Stockpiling belongings on the dock and using dock carts prematurely will inhibit the mobility of the staff getting houseboats ready for departure. It also slows the loading and unloading process for guests already assigned houseboats. *It is imperative to relay this to everyone in your party.*

After check-in you may start loading your houseboat. This is a good time to watch the 20-minute houseboat operation video which must be viewed by all captains and co-captains before the personal orientation can begin.



PERSONAL ORIENTATION

After loading your boat and viewing an orientation video, you and the co-captain will receive a personal orientation. All captains receive an orientation no matter how experienced they may be. Since every boat and location may differ or change from year to year we do this primarily for your safety, the safety of other boaters, and to enable you to use your houseboat to its greatest capacity. The personal orientation can last from 20 minutes to an hour but cannot begin until you and your co-captain have viewed the orientation video and are on the houseboat ready to begin. Upon completion of the personal orientation, our customer service representative will assist you in casting off and leaving the marina area. *Helpful Hint: Log on to houseboats.com and download the Houseboat Manual (click on Trip Preparation - Prior to Your Arrival and choose the model you reserved).*

LAUNCHING

There is a public launch ramp in Jones Valley Cove which is operated by the Shasta Recreation Company (see map on back). The fee to launch all boats is \$6.00 per day, which includes parking.

Jones Valley Resort has a small private ramp available to our guests at no charge. Because the ramp is located in the same vicinity as our loading zone, space is limited and this area tends to get congested. At times it will not be possible to gain access to our ramp. Since lake levels and traffic conditions fluctuate, we ask that you get the status of your houseboat prior to launching your personal vessel.

RETURN

Return the vessel on the starboard (right) side of the marina as you are approaching. To assist you in docking, a staff member will be shuttled to your houseboat. It is not necessary to inform the reservationist that you have returned to the dock. After your houseboat has been unloaded and a general cleanup has been completed, a representative will conduct a "walk through". Your gas charges and any damages or missing inventory will be reported to the marina store. After you have paid for your charges at the store you will receive your deposit refund check. We ask that you not rely on using the deposit refund check to pay for any charges. The store does not always have enough change to handle cashing your refund check.

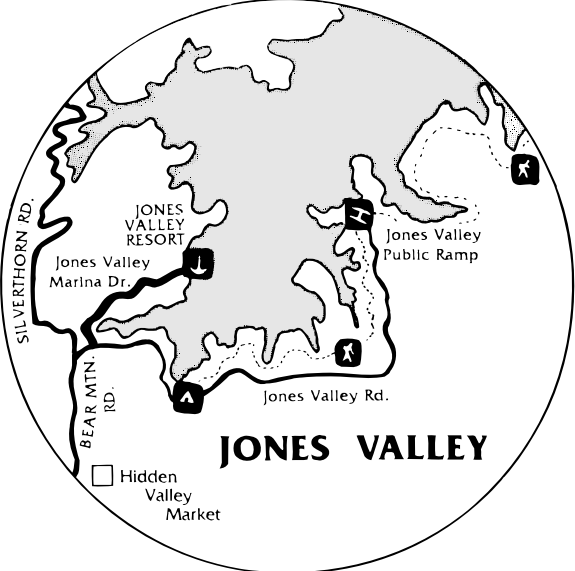
RECREATION CENTER
